Your Journey at NUH Emergency Department (Walk-in)

Temperature Screening

(5 - 10 mins)



Our staff will take your temperature and do a simple health declaration check.

Registration & Payment (5 - 15 mins)



For your convenience, A&E registration and payment will be done here. Patient may be isolated if condition is suspected to be contagious.

Triage

(15 - 60 mins)



Patients assessed to have more urgent conditions will be seen in another observation area.

Consultation

(1.5 - 3 hours)



Assessment by a doctor and possible additional tests* (e.g. x-ray, blood test). The doctor will decide if you require admission.

Discharge

Collection of Medicine (15 - 45 mins)



*Additional charge will be collected for non-standard drugs or investigations.

Ward

Inpatient Admission (3 - 20 hours)



You will be transferred once there is an available bed in your ward class.
