“Prior to receiving the transplant, I was advised not to conceive as I had toxins in my body from kidney disease. I expressed my desire of giving birth to the National University Centre for Organ Transplantation (NUCOT) team, and they worked with the Obstetrics & Gynaecology team at NUH. I was prescribed post-transplant medication that was safe for conception and gave birth smoothly a year later.” – Serene, kidney transplant recipient.
