<b>Fever (38.0°C and above)</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Is above 3 months old</li> <li>• Has a fever of less than 40°C</li> <li>• Has a fever for 5 days or less</li> <li>• Is still active and drinking well</li> <li>• Has no change in urine output</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Is above 3 months old</li> <li>• Has a fever of less than 41°C</li> <li>• Has prolonged fever for 5 days or more</li> <li>• Is drinking less but at least half of the usual fluid intake</li> <li>• Has a decrease in urine output</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Is below 3 months old</li> <li>• Has a fever of more than 41°C</li> <li>• Is feeling lethargic</li> <li>• Has breathing difficulties</li> <li>• Has a fit</li> <li>• Is drinking less than half of the usual fluid intake</li> <li>• Has no urine output for the past 8 hours</li> </ul>
<b>Gastroenteritis</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Has mild vomiting and/or diarrhoea</li> <li>• Is drinking as per normal</li> <li>• Remains active</li> <li>• Has no change in urine output</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Has persistent vomiting</li> <li>• Has mild blood-streaked diarrhoea</li> <li>• Has abdominal pain that comes and goes</li> <li>• Is drinking less but at least half of the usual fluid intake</li> <li>• Has a decrease in urine output</li> <li>• Is slightly more tired than usual but mostly active</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Has severe vomiting with blood and bile-stained fluid</li> <li>• Has severe bloody diarrhoea</li> <li>• Has severe abdominal pain</li> <li>• Is drinking less than half of the usual fluid intake</li> <li>• Has no urine output for more than 8 hours</li> <li>• Is lethargic</li> </ul>
<b>Upper Respiratory Tract Infection</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Has fever, mild cough, runny or blocked nose</li> <li>• Have no breathing difficulties</li> <li>• Is drinking as per normal</li> <li>• Remains active</li> <li>• Has no change in urine output</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Is slightly more breathless than usual</li> <li>• Has a mild wheeze or noisy breathing</li> <li>• Is drinking less but at least half of the usual fluid intake</li> <li>• Has a decrease in urine output</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Is lethargic</li> <li>• Has breathing difficulties and looks blue</li> <li>• Is drinking less than half of the usual fluid intake</li> <li>• Has no urine output for the past 8 hours</li> </ul>
<b>Hand, foot and mouth disease (HFMD)</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Has fever and rash over hands, feet and/or mouth</li> <li>• Is feeding as per normal or with slightly reduced intake</li> <li>• Remains active</li> <li>• Has no change in urine output</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Is drinking less but at least half of the usual fluid intake</li> <li>• Has a decrease in urine output</li> <li>• Is less active</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Is lethargic</li> <li>• Is drinking less than half of the usual fluid intake</li> <li>• Has no urine output for more than 8 hours</li> <li>• Has headache</li> </ul>
